Dear North Central School Community,

North Central Local Schools are committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that we have recently received information that 1 student in the North Central Local School District tested positive for COVID-19. We are working closely with the Williams County Health Department, and as a part of the COVID-19 investigation the health department will notify anyone identified as a close contact. **This recent spike since late October/ early November and now December has resulted in close to 200 students and 43 staff to be affected by quarantine, positive COVID 19 test, or having to stay with someone that is affected by COVID 19 in some way.**

We ask you to take the following steps and to monitor your child's health:

- 1) As a precaution, consider postponing plans for playdates, family visits, and social activities for the next 14 days. (Stay home when you are sick)
- 2) Continue to check your child for COVID-19 symptoms daily: fever or chills, new uncontrolled cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, new onset of severe headache, especially with fever.
  - If anyone in your household develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID19, they should immediately isolate and contact their medical provider.
  - If NO symptoms develop and you have not been instructed to quarantine, your child may continue to attend school.

Thank you for helping to keep people safe and to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community and school.
