The WCHD is collaborating with North Central Local Schools to provide the *OPTION* for your students ages 16 and older to receive FREE COVID-19 vaccines during the school day if parental or legal consent is provided. The COVID-19 vaccine is a safe and effective tool that can be used to keep families safe and healthy, protect our community from the virus, and help Williams County return to normal.

To register your student to receive a free vaccine at school, the student's parent or guardian must complete the attached consent form and turn it into the school office by Wednesday May 5, 2021. Emailed copies of the consent form will be accepted and can be sent to mrozevink@northcentralschool.org or kewers@northcentralschool.org. The vaccine will be given only to students who have turned in a signed consent form. A parent is not required to be present for the vaccine.

For the school clinic, the Pfizer vaccine will be provided. The Pfizer vaccine is approved for students who are 16 years and older. For full protection, two doses are needed approximately 3 weeks or 21 days apart.

The first dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be given during the school day on **Thursday May 6, 2021 at 1:15 PM in The NC Eagle Room.**

The second dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be given during the school day on **Friday May 27, 2021 at 8:30 AM in The NC Eagle Room.**

If these dates are not convenient for your student or if you would like to be present for the vaccine, you can schedule an appointment at the Williams County Health Department. To schedule your appointment, you can choose a date and time at bit.ly/WCVaccine or call the Call Center at 419-636-0081.
